Safety Tips

- Position on a flat, stable surface.
- A service agent/qualified technician should carry out installation and any repairs if required.
- Consult Local and National Standards to comply with the following:

- DO NOT immerse the appliance in water, or use jet/pressure washers to clean the appliance.
- Do not store explosive substances such as aerosol cans with a flammable propellant inside the appliance.
- Do not use the appliance for anything other than its intended use.
- Always switch off and disconnect the power supply to the appliance when not in use.
- Not suitable for outdoor use.
- Keep all packaging away from children. Dispose of the packaging in accordance to the regulations of local authorities.
- If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by a POLAR agent or a recommended qualified technician in order to avoid a hazard.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning the use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- Polar recommend that this appliance is PAT tested on an annual basis to ensure the product remains safe.

Installation



Note: If the appliance has been stored or moved in a non-vertical position, stand it in an upright position for approximately 12 hours before operation. If in doubt allow to stand.

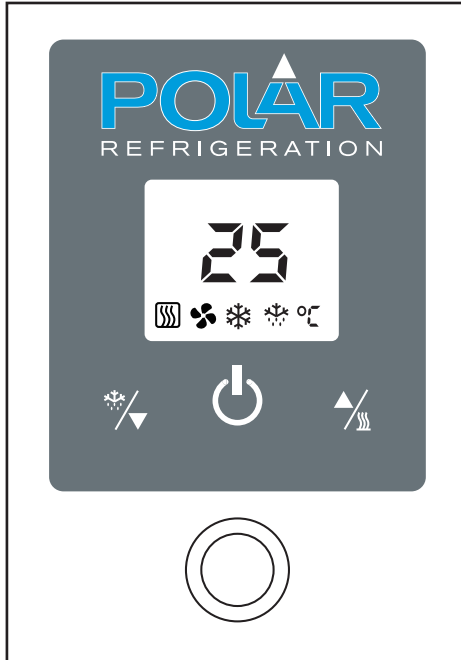
1. Remove the appliance from the packaging and remove the protective film from all surfaces.
2. When positioning, maintain a distance of 20cm (7 inches) between the appliance and walls or other objects for ventilation. **NEVER LOCATE NEXT TO OR NEAR A HEAT SOURCE.**



Note: Maximum load of shelves is 15kg

To switch refrigeration system on or off press and hold for 3 seconds

Adjusting the Temperature

1. Press button for 1 second. °C on the LCD display will flash.
2. Press up button or down button to change the set temperature.
3. Wait 6 seconds for the set temperature to be stored.

Manual Defrost

1. To start manual defrost press defrost button and hold for 6 seconds.
2. To stop manual or automatic defrost press defrost button .

Glass Heater

- To turn on Glass Heater press Glass Heater button for 3 seconds. Display will show .
- To switch off Glass Heater press Glass Heater button for 3 seconds.

Cleaning, Care & Maintenance



Switch off and disconnect from the power supply before cleaning

- The doors can be removed for ease of cleaning
- Clean the interior of the appliance as often as possible
- Do not use abrasive cleaning agents. These can leave harmful residues
- Clean the door seals with warm water
- Always wipe dry after cleaning

Replacing the Interior Lamp

Call your POLAR dealer or a qualified electrician, the Lamp Assembly is available to purchase as a spare part.

Cleaning the Condenser



The condenser is part of the refrigeration system. The condenser requires monthly cleaning.

1. The condenser is located on the right-hand side of the refrigeration cabinet at the rear.
2. Remove the screws fixing the right-hand panel by hand.
3. Remove the right side panel to access the filter.
4. Clean with a vacuum cleaner.
5. Re-attach the panel and fix it with the screws removed beforehand.

Troubleshooting

If the machine malfunctions due to causes other than those listed or the proposed corrective actions do not solve the problem please call a Polar agent or qualified technician

Fault	Probable Cause	Solution
The appliance is not working	The unit is not switched on	Check the unit is plugged in correctly and switched on
	Plug and lead are damaged	Call POLAR agent or qualified Technician
	Fuse in the plug has blown	Replace the plug fuse
	Power supply	Check power supply
	Internal wiring fault	Call POLAR agent or qualified Technician
The appliance is not cooling	Coolant Leak	Call POLAR agent or qualified technician
	Fan Motor Failed	Call POLAR agent or qualified technician
	Airflow to the condenser obstructed	Increase the gap between appliance and obstacles/heat source
	Condenser is clogged	→ Cleaning the Condenser
The Light does not work	Bulb has blown	Replace Bulb with identical type
	Bulb Starter has blown	Replace Starter with identical type

Electrical Wiring

The plug is to be connected to a suitable mains socket.

This appliance is wired as follows:

- Live wire (coloured brown) to terminal marked L
- Neutral wire (coloured blue) to terminal marked N
- Earth wire (coloured green/yellow) to terminal marked E

All POLAR appliances must be earthed, using a dedicated earthing circuit.



If in doubt consult a qualified electrician.

Electrical isolation points must be kept clear of any obstructions. In the event of any emergency disconnection being required they must be readily accessible.
